OCCUPATIONAL TAX (BUSINESS LICENSE)

The term “employee” shall mean an individual whose work is performed under the direction and supervision of the employer and whose employer withholds FICA, Federal Income Tax, or State Income Tax from such individual’s compensation or whose employer issues to such individual for the purposes of documenting compensation a form IRS W-2 but not a form IRS 1099.

Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) from 0-1 employee and each additional employee shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) not to exceed two hundred fifty-five dollars (\$255.00). Total fees including employee fee plus administrative fee is not to exceed two hundred and eighty dollars (\$280.00). **Beer and Wine Licenses require additional fee.**
